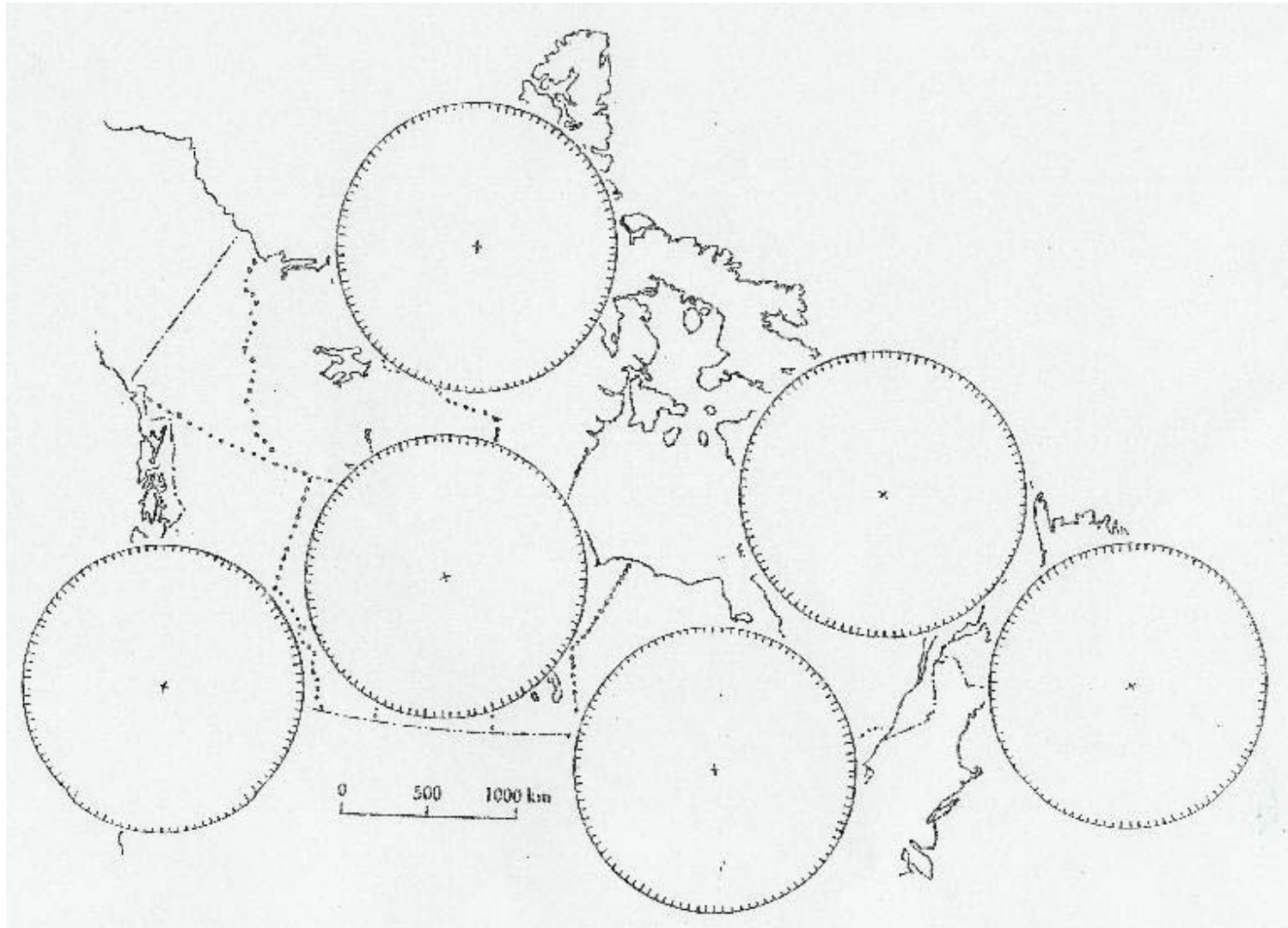




Ethnic Distribution in Canada
