



# Methods of Fishing in Canada



In Shore	Off Shore
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• small boats with limited gear, self-employed</li> <li>• 85% of fishers but just 10% of fish</li> <li>• day trips only, no trips during bad weather</li> <li>• low income</li> <li>• lobster, shrimp, clam, cod, and haddock</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• large ships with variety of gear, company owned</li> <li>• 15% of fishers but 90% of fish</li> <li>• out for two weeks or more at a time, in any weather</li> <li>• reasonable income</li> <li>• harvest cod, sole, halibut, redfish, flounder</li> </ul>
