

# Ending Conflict Between Governments



1. Become familiar with the eight different foreign policy tools.
2. Divide yourselves into six equally sized groups and discuss the specific example of a global conflict that will be given to you.
3. Determine the various foreign policy tools that were available at the time and that could have been applied in order to resolve it.
4. Determine the specific option that was ultimately employed and the reasons for this.
5. Which foreign policy *goal(s)* were involved in your situation? Were these goals achieved through the application of a specific foreign policy tool?
6. Of all the foreign policy tools available to be used, which one *should* have been used to resolve the situation?
7. Report back to the class with your analysis of the ways in which foreign policy tools are applied to specific conflict situations in order to achieve foreign policy goals.
8. Individually, write a half page summary of a situation not discussed in class that Canada was or is involved in, and clearly explain in another half page which tool(s) were available to be used, which tool(s) were used, and which tool(s) should have been used when dealing with that particular situation.
