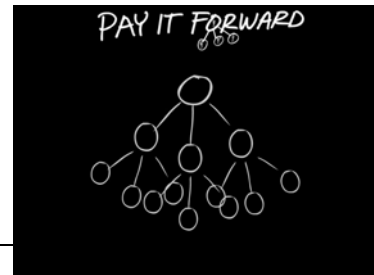


Pay It Forward

Your Task



1. In groups of 4 or 5, come up with your own idea to make the world a better place. You will have two class periods to work on it and then will make brief presentations about your proposal at the beginning of the third class. A maximum two-page report will be submitted providing further details of your proposal.
2. Your proposal must be feasible. It can not involve vast sums of money or resources that are not available to you.
3. Your proposal must be meaningful. You must clearly state intended outcomes as to how your proposal will positively affect the lives of a significantly sized population.
4. Your proposal must be detailed. Clearly identify the manpower, resources, finances, contacts, and skills required to ensure success of your proposal.
5. Use visuals such as photographs, statistical graphs, maps, flowcharts, or other types to make a convincing presentation to the class that your plan is needed and it will work.
6. Work together. You will be asked to reflect upon your group's dynamics and proportional participation of your group members.

- is your report detailed?

Thinking

- are there relevant statistics and facts to show that there is a need?
- are there relevant statistics and facts to show details of the resources required?

Communication

- is your report and presentation professional, visually appealing, and convincing?

Application

- is your proposal feasible and meaningful?
