17. The Prime Minister has requested that key Canadian installations are to be protected by the Canadian Forces, but the commanders felt they don't enough troops.... which allows the Prime Minister to do what?
18. Industry CEO Frommer wants to talk with Lavigne about what?
19. The Prime Minister speaks to the public about the ridiculousness of what?
20. All the while, he has ordered a rogue group of individuals to do what?
21. What does the Prime Minister propose to the US Ambassador?
22. Meanwhile, what is Marc Lavigne trying to do before the vote in Parliament?
23. How does the U.S. ultimately respond to the "Canadian Crisis"?

For those who are interested, the protocols, titles, and references to Canadian historical names, dates, and facts are accurate (with the exception of the "Canadian Federal Police" and the voting procedure in the House of Commons):

- Tupper as a short-lived PM in the 1890s
- close election of King as Liberal leader in 1919
- 24 Sussex Drive's *Gorffwysfa* name meaning of "place of peace" in Welsh
- reference as "Minister" or "Prime Minister" and not "Mr. Minister" or "Mr. Prime Minister" (although, as in reality, some people *do* use these inappropriate titles, such as the US Ambassador)
- powers of the Federal Cabinet within the *Emergencies Act*
