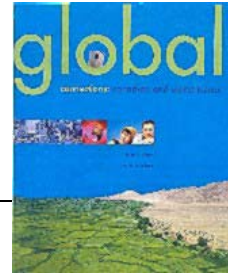


Global Connections Textbook Assignment:

1. Gauge your starting point for World Issues by answering questions 1-12 on page 3 in your notes.
2. Read Chapter 1 in *Global Connections*. Check your understanding of this topic by defining the terms in **bold letters** that appear throughout the chapter. If you would like an official definition for each term, they are listed in the glossary at the back of the textbook.
3. A handout will be provided in class dealing with the questions about measuring your perspective on pages 5 & 6, but if you can't wait for the handout or have misplaced the handout, the questions are there for you.
4. In a group of approximately 4 students, come to a group consensus on the activities below.
 - a. What is an issue?
 - b. List six major issues facing humanity.
 - c. Examine the major issues suggested by all of the groups and create four or five headings under which they may be grouped (e.g., environmental issues).
